<p>ITEM 10</p> <p align="center">STATION LISTS AND CONDITIONS</p> <p>This publication is governed by the Official Railroad Station List, OPSL 6000-series, issued by RAILINC, Agent.</p>	<p>ITEM 100</p> <p align="center">CARS SUBJECT TO DEMURRAGE RULES AND CHARGES</p> <p>Railroad, railroad controlled, and private cars held for or by consignees and consignors for any purpose are subject to the demurrage rules and charges described in this tariff. All cars of TTX Company will be considered railroad controlled equipment.</p> <p>Exception: Demurrage rules and charges contained herein will not apply to empty or loaded private cars held on private tracks.</p>
<p>ITEM 20</p> <p align="center">REFERENCE TO TARIFFS, ITEMS, NOTES, RULES, ETC.</p> <p>Where reference is made in this tariff to tariffs, items, notes, rules, circulars, etc., such references are continuous and include supplements to and successive issues of such tariffs, and reissues of such items, notes, rules, circulars, etc.</p>	<p>ITEM 110</p> <p align="center">HOLIDAYS</p> <p>Wherever in this tariff reference is made to "Holidays" it means the following:</p> <p align="center"> New Year's Day – January 1 (See Note) Memorial Day – Last Monday of May US Independence Day – July 4 (See Note) Labor Day – First Monday of September Thanksgiving Day – Fourth Thursday of November Christmas Day – December 25 (See Note) New Year's Eve – December 31 (See Note) </p> <p>Note – When this day occurs on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday will be observed as the holiday.</p>
<p>ITEM 30</p> <p align="center">METHOD OF CANCELLING ITEMS</p> <p>As this tariff is supplemented, numbered items with lettered suffixes cancel correspondingly numbered items in the original tariff or in a prior supplement. Letter suffixes will be used in alphabetical sequences starting with A. For example: Item 100-A cancels Item 100 and Item 200-B cancels Item 200-A in a prior supplement, which in turn cancelled Item 200.</p>	<p>ITEM 120</p> <p align="center">FREE TIME</p> <p>Free time will be allowed for each car as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Two business days from the first midnight following actual or constructive placement. Holidays as listed in Item 110, provided that a chargeable day has not occurred prior to the holiday. Saturdays and Sundays, provided that a chargeable day has not occurred prior to the Saturday or Sunday.

<p>ITEM 75</p> <p align="center">CARS HELD FOR PAYMENT</p> <p>Cars held for payment of freight or accessorial charges will accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. However, no free time will be granted.</p>	<p>ITEM 80</p> <p align="center">CARS HELD FOR SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS</p> <p>Cars held for shipping instructions will accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. However, no free time will be granted.</p>
<p>ITEM 90</p> <p align="center">CARS HELD FOR LOAD ADJUSTMENT</p> <p>Cars held for the adjustment of lading will accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. <p>ITEM 140</p> <p align="center">DEMURRAGE CHARGES</p> <p>On cars subject to demurrage charges, after the expiration of free time, a charge of \$65.00 per chargeable day, or fraction thereof, will be assessed until the car is released by the customer.</p> <p>Exception: Cars assigned AAR mechanical designations FD, FM, or FW with a load capacity in excess of 200,000 lbs. or cars listed in the tariffs below will be subject to demurrage charges of \$75.00 per day.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tariff RIC 6740-series, Naming Use and Car Detention Charges on Special Type Heavy-Duty Flat Cars. 2. Tariff RER 6414-series, The Official Railway Equipment Register, Heavy Duty and Special Flat Car Section. 	<p>ITEM 200</p> <p align="center">CONDITIONS OF STORAGE</p> <p>COER will accept private cars for storage on the conditions listed herein and all other applicable tariffs. Cars will be stored subject to track availability. Customer, at customer's sole expense, shall provide COER a certificate of insurance coverage certifying the existence of general liability insurance coverage.</p> <hr/> <p>ITEM 210</p> <p align="center">STORAGE HOLD CHARGES</p> <p>Private cars, loaded or empty, held on COER storage/hold tracks at customer request, will be subject to a storage hold charge of \$15.00 per day, or fraction thereof, computed from the time car is first held until car is released from storage hold.</p> <hr/> <p>ITEM 220</p> <p align="center">[1]</p> <p align="center">SWITCHING TO AND FROM STORAGE/HOLD TRACKS</p> <p>A charge of \$300.00 will be assessed per car for cars switched into and out of storage. The charge will be assessed in each direction.</p>
