GENERAL CAR DEMURRAGE RULES AND CHARGES

ITEM	SUBJECT	APPLICATION
SECTION 1		
40	DEMURRAGE CHARGES	<p>On cars subject to demurrage charges after expiration of free time allowed (See Item 60), the following charges per car per day, or fraction of a day, will be made until the car is released (See Exceptions 1 through 3).</p> <p>\$25.00 for the first chargeable day.</p> <p>\$25.00 for each subsequent day.</p> <p>The applicable charge will accrue on all Saturdays, Sundays and holidays (See Item 70) subsequent to the first chargeable day, including a Saturday, Sunday or holiday (See Item 70) immediately following the day on which the first chargeable day begins to run.</p> <p>Exception 1 - Demurrage Rules and Charges published herein will NOT apply to "XM" box cars of Gulf, Colorado & San Saba Railway ownership leased to shippers for storage of commodities.</p> <p>Exception 2 - Demurrage Rules and Charges published herein will NOT apply on cars of Gulf, Colorado & San Saba Railway ownership placed for loading at stations on the Gulf, Colorado & San Saba Railway.</p> <p>Exception 3 - This tariff is NOT applicable to private or leased cars held on industry owned or leased tracks where ownership of car and the track is the same.</p>
SECTION 2		
50	EMPTY CARS ORDERED OR APPROPRIATED FOR LOADING BUT NOT USED	<p>When a car so ordered and placed is not used, and no advice from the party who ordered the car has been received within seventy-two (72) hours, exclusive of Saturdays and Sundays, demurrage charges will start from the first 7:00 A.M. after car is placed and will be charged until the car has been removed from the loading location.</p>
SECTION 3 - EXPLANATION OF TERMS		
60	FREE TIME	<p>Cars for loading and unloading will be given seventy-two (72) hours free time to complete loading or unloading. Free time starts at first 7:00 A.M. after the car is placed, or notification is given.</p> <p>SPECIAL NOTE: GCSR PROVIDES THREE (3) TURNS PER WEEK.</p>
70	HOLIDAYS	<p>Wherever reference is made to "holidays", it shall mean only the days listed below.</p> <p>New Year's Day - January 1 (See Note). Memorial Day - Last Monday of May. Independence Day - July 4 (See Note). Labor Day - First Monday of September. Thanksgiving Day - Fourth Thursday of November. Christmas Day - December 25 (See Note).</p> <p>NOTE: When this date occurs on a Sunday, the following Monday will be observed as the holiday.</p>
SECTION 4		
80	NOTIFICATION	<p>Notification by GCSR and/or industry of arrival or release of cars will be:</p> <p>A. In writing by fax or otherwise; B. By personal or phone communication.</p>
90	PLACEMENT OF CARS	<p>Cars will be considered placed when:</p> <p>A. Car is placed in an accessible position for loading or unloading. B. Car cannot be actually placed through no fault of GCSR, and notification is given to consignor of constructive placement at a hold point on GCSR. Free time will be computed as shown in Item 60.</p>
