<p><b>RULES AND OTHER GOVERNING PROVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS-GENERAL</b></p>	<p><b>SECTION 1 DEMURRAGE RULES AND CHARGE</b></p>
<p><b>ITEM 10 STATION LISTS AND CONDITIONS</b></p> <p>This publication is governed by the Official Railroad Station List, OP SL 6000 -series, issued by RAILINC, Agent.</p>	<p><b>ITEM 100 CARS SUBJECT TO DEMURRAGE RULES AND CHARGES</b></p> <p>Railroad, railroad controlled, and private cars held for or by consignees and consignors for any purpose are subject to the demurrage rules and charges described in this tariff. All cars of TTX Company are railroad controlled equipment.</p> <p>Note - Demurrage rules and charges contained herein will not apply to empty or loaded private cars held on private tracks.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 20 REFERENCE TO TARIFFS, ITEMS, NOTES, RULES, ETC.</b></p> <p>Where reference is made in this tariff to tariffs, items, notes, rules, etc., such references are continuous and include supplements to and successive issues of such tariffs, and reissues of such items, notes, rules, etc.</p>	<p><b>ITEM 110 CHARGEABLE DAYS</b></p> <p>Chargeable days are defined as days that follow the expiration of free time as described in Item 120.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 30 METHOD OF CANCELLING ITEMS</b></p> <p>As this tariff is supplemented, numbered items with lettered suffixes cancel correspondingly numbered items in the original tariff or in a prior supplement. Letter suffixes will be used in alphabetical sequences starting with A. For example: Item 100-A cancels Item 100 and Item 200-B cancels Item 200-A in a prior supplement, which in turn cancelled Item 200.</p>	<p><b>ITEM 120 FREE TIME</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Saturdays and Sundays are not chargeable demurrage days, except when preceded by a chargeable demurrage day.</li> <li>The following US holidays are free time: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>New Year's Day - January 1 (See Note)</li> <li>Memorial Day - Last Monday of May</li> <li>US Independence Day - July 4 (See Note)</li> <li>Labor Day - First Monday of September</li> <li>Thanksgiving Day - Fourth Thursday of November</li> <li>Christmas Day - December 25 (See Note)</li> <li>New Year's Eve - December 31 (See Note)</li> </ul> <p>Note - When this day occurs on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday will be observed as the holiday.</p> </li> <li>Forty-eight (48) hours free time will be allowed for cars held for loading and unloading. The start of the forty-eight (48) hours of free time will commence at the first 0700 after placement or notification, whichever occurs first.</li> </ol>
<p><b>RULES AND OTHER GOVERNING PROVISIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS-UNLIMITED</b></p>	<p><b>ITEM 130 DEMURRAGE CHARGES</b></p> <p>On cars subject to demurrage charges, after the expiration of free time, a charge of \$65.00 per car per day, or fraction thereof will be assessed until the car is released.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 75 CARS HELD FOR PAYMENT</b></p> <p>Cars held for payment of freight or accessorial charges shall accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. However no credit days shall be granted.</p>	
<p><b>ITEM 80 CARS HELD FOR SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS</b></p> <p>Cars held for shipping instructions will accrue demurrage charges at the same rate as normal demurrage charges. However no credit days shall be granted.</p>
