### **SPECIAL SWITCHING SERVICE**

Special switching service is movement in other than normal service at the specific request of the shipper or consignee, or as may be required due to other conditions outside normal operations or deemed necessary by this railroad for safe movement.

The charge for special switching service will be \$300.00 per hour, minimum of \$600.00, and will be in addition to all other charges associated with movement.

Charges to be calculated from the time the crew and locomotive report for special service until the return of crew and locomotive to starting point.

(Normal service, Monday thru Friday, 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., start and end times subject to adjustment by railroad, and excluding the holidays (See Item 60).

Special switching service is available outside of normal service hours and on holidays (See Item 60) and weekends. Special switching service is based on customer order submitted at least twenty-four hours in advance of service time.)
