RULES AND OTHER GOVERNING PROVISIONS GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 100-A

APPLICATION

- A. Applicable at all stations on TSRR.
- B. The disposition of a car at its point of detention determines the purpose for which the car is held and the rules applicable thereto.
- C. All railroad and privately owned cars held for or by consignors or consignees are subject to demurrage rules and charges contained in this tariff, except the following:
 - 1. Cars for loading or unloading of TSRR company material while held on TSRR tracks or private sidings connecting therewith.
 - 2. Cars of refused or unclaimed freight to be sold by TSRR for the time held beyond legal requirements.
 - 3. Railroad owned cars assigned to shippers returned empty to point of assignment, to the extent storage rules apply.
 - 4. Cars moving on own wheels under transportation charges as freight.
 - 5. Cars of railroad ownership, leased for storage of commodities, while held on lessee's tracks.
 - 6. Loaded private cars held on private tracks.
 - 7. Empty private cars held on private tracks.
 - 8. Cars specially equipped for handling welded railroad rail held for loading such rail.
 - 9. Empty cars ordered and rejected as unsuitable for loading.

STORAGE RULES AND CHARGES

ITEM 2000

APPLICATION

Rules and charges herein apply to storage of:

(a) Empty assigned cars

(b) Cars moving on own wheels, as freight, under transportation charges

(c) Cars of Explosives, Hazardous Materials, Substances or Wastes subject to Tariff ICC BOE 6000 held on railroad tracks.

ITEM 2100

COMPUTING TIME

Storage days will commence from the first 7:00 A.M. following notice of arrival and continue until the car assumes demurrage status or until the car is released.

ITEM 2200

STORAGE CHARGES

- 1. \$15.00 per car per storage day, or fraction thereof, on:
 - (a) Assigned cars
 - (b) Railway equipment moving on own wheels
- 2. \$30.00 per car per storage day, or fraction thereof, on:
 - (a) Cars of Explosives, Hazardous Materials, Substances or Wastes, subject to Tariff ICC BOE 6000. (Demurrage charges will be in addition to storage charge.)
