RULES AND OTHER GOVERNING PROVISIONS GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 10

SUPPLEMENTS AND REISSUES

When reference is made in this tariff, or supplements, to other publications for rates or other information, it includes "Supplements thereto or successive issues thereof."

Where reference is made in this tariff to items, it includes "resisues" of such items.

ITEM 20

METHOD OF CANCELLING ITEMS

As this tariff is supplemented, numbered items with letter suffixes cancel correspondingly numbered items in the original tariff, or in a prior supplement. Letter suffixes will be used in alphabetical sequence starting with A. Example: Item 100-A cancels Item 100 and Item 300-B cancels Item 300-A in a prior supplement which, in turn, cancelled Item 300.

SECTION 1 SWITCHING RULES AND CHARGES

ITEM 100

DEFINITION OF INTRA-PLANT SWITCHING

A switching movement from one track to another within the same plant or industry, or from one location to another location on the same track within the same plant or industry.

ITEM 110

DEFINITION OF INTRA-TERMINAL SWITCHING

A switching movement (other than intra-plant switching) from one track to another track of the same railroad, or between the track(s) of an industry and the track of the railroad or between the tracks of two separate industries served by the same railroad.

ITEM 120

DEFINITION OF INTER-TERMINAL SWITCHING

A switching movement from a track of one carrier to a track of another carrier when both tracks are within the switching limits of the same station or industrial district.

ITEM 130

INTRA-PLANT SWITCHING CHARGE

The TSRR will perform intra-plant switching at a charge of \$110.00 per car.

SECTION 1 SWITCHING RULES AND CHARGES

ITEM 140

INTRA-TERMINAL SWITCHING CHARGE

The TSRR will perform intra-terminal switching at a charge of \$270.00 per car.

ITEM 150

INTER-TERMINAL SWITCHING CHARGE

The TSRR will perform inter-terminal switching at a charge of \$250.00 per car.

INTERCHANGE/RECIPROCAL SWITCHING

The TSRR will perform switching between industries located at stations on the TSRR named below and interchange with CSXT at Natco, TN at the following charges:

Cars moved onto tracks of the TSRR by connecting carrier for purposes other than for interchange to or from TSRR will be subject to the following charges:

ITEM 210

TURNING OF CARS TO PERMIT LOADING, ETC.

If, as result of request, cars are turned to facilitate loading, unloading or for any other purpose, a charges of \$150.00 per car will be assessed requesting party, and will be in addition to all other applicable charges.

Note. - The above charge will not apply to properly placarded boxcars.
