APPLICATION OF FUEL SURCHARGE

Due to the increase in the price of fuel, the Tulsa-Sapulpa Union Railway Company (TSU) retains the right to apply a fuel surcharge in an amount up to \$50.00 per car on all traffic interchanged with the BNSF at Sapulpa, OK.

Surcharge to be paid by the rail user (i.e., receiver or consignee on inbound shipments, and shipper or consignor on outbound shipments), and to be collected by and accrue solely to the TSU.

In the event the U. S. Average Price of Retail On-Highway Diesel Fuel (HDF) for the prior month of shipment drops below \$1.30 per gallon, the above surcharge will not apply.

This tariff is also applicable on intrastate traffic, except where expressly provided to the contrary.
